





People and Places Stage 1 - Geography





Students through inquiry solidify their understanding of the importance of outdoor places to people and communication of geographical information and use of geographical tools

Learning Experiences

Students begin the day by being provided with some inquiry questions we hope to answer by the end of the day. Students utilise geographical tools to help determine what a location is like and what makes it important to them and to others in their community.



Outcomes

Student:

describes features of places and the connections people have with places GE1-1

identifies ways in which people interact with and care for places GE1-2

communicates geographical information and uses geographical tools for inquiry GE1-3

Content

Australian places

Students:

- investigate places across a range of scales within Australia for example: (ACHGK010)
- identification that places exist across a range of scales eg personal, local and national

People's connections to places Students:

- investigate people's connections and access to places, for example:
- discussion of why people visit other places
- identification of factors influencing people's accessibility to places eg distance
- examination of how technology has improved people's access to places
- Local and global connections

Students:

 investigate connections that people, including Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples, have to local and global places
